



The new buses for the Metrobus m1 – a fact sheet

Brand new biogas buses

The new m1 Metrobus route, operated by Bristol Community Transport, will run using 21 brand new double deck Scania ADL Enviro400 CBG buses fuelled by biogas.

Our aim is to provide the highest possible quality of service with the lowest possible carbon footprint. Choosing biogas, a carbon-neutral fuel source, will help us to achieve this aim. The buses are very green indeed – they use gas that has been generated from waste, like food peelings or manure, instead of diesel.

Easily get on and off-able

The more easily everyone can get on and off the bus, the faster everyone reaches their destination. The new buses feature two sets of doors – so people getting on and off aren't in each other's way.

The 'new pay before you board' system means that no-one is fumbling for change – it's up to five times faster to load a bus if people pay for a ticket at an iPoint. We'll also be accepting First's M-tickets, travelwest smartcards and concession passes – you can even use contactless at the iPoints too.

What's also important is that *everyone* can get on and off easily. The buses can 'kneel' to offer step free access from the kerb at metrobus stops and have powered wheelchair ramps, making sure everyone can travel.

Sit back and enjoy the ride

Metrobus is a smarter way of travelling – and the new buses reflect that with a range of features and creature comforts. The buses will be well-presented in the smart Metrobus livery, have comfortable seats, free Wi-Fi and USB charging points. There is also real-time information, with next stop audio and video, making sure passengers can keep a track of their journey.

Safer journeys for everyone

Safety is an essential part of what we do – for our passengers, our staff and other road users. The buses will be fitted with Cycle Eye, a system that provides a warning to the driver if a cyclist is undertaking. The buses will also include CCTV, helping to ensure passengers' security. They will also be fitted with telematics, which alerts drivers to over-harsh braking or acceleration.
